Please note- the children **must be able to carry their own suitcase** on and off the ferries and to the coaches as we travel around the island, so do not over pack!

Kit List

- Toiletries
- One smallish towel- not bath size please!
- Swim suit and swimming towel or wrap
- Sun cream/ sun hat
- **Waterproof** coat to carry daily and waterproof trousers- we will be out all day on some days, even if it rains
- **Small comfortable** rucksack to carry waterproofs, lunch, drink bottle, snacks
- **Comfortable** walking boots/shoes/trainers X2 (in case they get wet!)
- Flip flops/crocs for indoors and walking to the pool
- Warm hat
- Plenty of layers for changes in weather and warmth – short and long sleeve T-shirts/Sweat shirts – 4 changes
- Trousers/leggings/shorts – 4 changes
- Nightwear
- Underwear and plenty of socks- two pairs per day
- Black sack for dirty washing
- Cuddly toy (compulsory)
- Small torch
- Drinking bottle - NAMED
- Cards/writing/drawing books/pencils/small games are good to take
- Reading books
- Camera- own responsibility

No sweets/food in suitcases please. A tuck shop is available daily.

Monday:

- Please make sure your child is dressed in warm clothes for the ferry crossing (we like to be outside if we can); the very windy Needles Battery and the equally windy beach.
- Children need a waterproof coat in their rucksack, a bottle of water, snacks and a packed lunch- they will not have access to their cases.
- Please come to the school hall, Mrs Hall will collect medicines, named with clear instructions, for the week.
- Pocket money (£10 is plenty) should be handed into Mrs Hall in a named purse.
