



Year 3 Beaulieu Residential

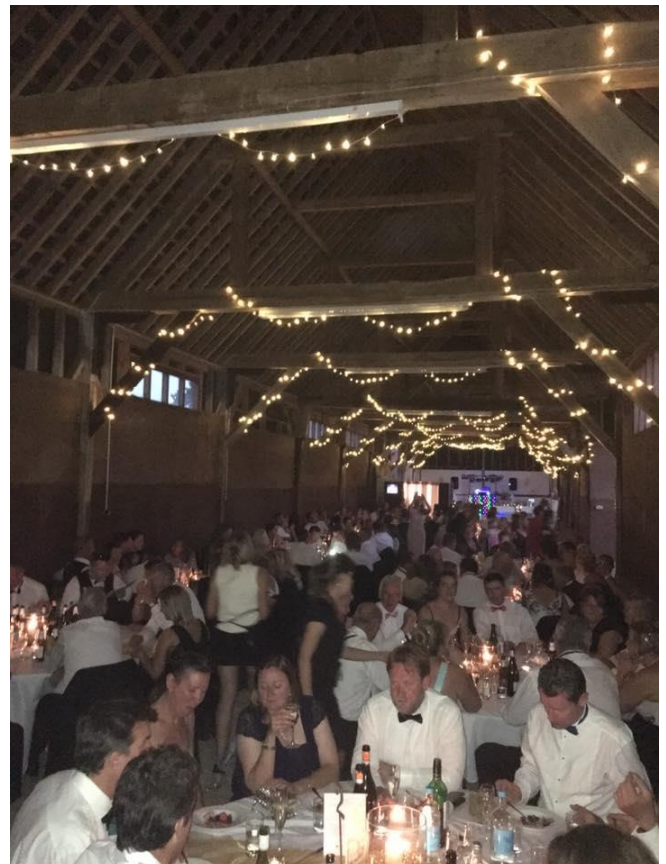
