A reminder that the Flu Immunisation consent form needs to be **completed and returned to school by Monday 13<sup>th</sup> November. If you decide you do not want to vaccinate your child against flu, please return the consent form giving the reason (this helps the school nursing team to improve and plan the service).**

We require a consent form for each child you have in Year R to Year 4 - please see the school office if you require another consent form or a leaflet which explains the vaccination programme.

The Flu vaccination will be offered in school on November 20<sup>th</sup> through a nasal spray as part of a national flu immunisation programme.
