

Wellow Sports Funding 2015-16



In 2013 the government announced plans to provide £150 million per annum for the for primary school sports funding. The funding is being jointly provided by Departments for Education; Health; and Culture, Media and Sport with money going directly to primary schools to spend on improving the quality of Sport and PE for all children in school.

Last year our use of Sports Premium funding included prioritising Staff CPD in gymnastics, dance and athletics, promoting and monitoring participation in Level 2 and 3 competitions and the development of dedicated space and equipment for sport and PE.

This year, to further develop Sport and PE provision at Wellow we aim to :

- ⇒ *Provide equipment and facilities to develop strength and balance for our youngest children*
- ⇒ *Extend the opportunities for children to access Level 1, Level 2 and Level 3 competition.*
- ⇒ *Introduce a 'Sports Star' award to raise the profile of sporting success within the school.*
- ⇒ *Increase the levels of participation of extra curricular sport both in and out of school*
- ⇒ *Provide further opportunities for children to try new sports and activities.*
- ⇒ *Promote a healthy lifestyle in all of our children.*

Total Grant Academic Year 2015-2016— £8585

Planned spend of the grant in 2015-16 will include:

- £2,000 - participation in local and regional sports competition via Personal Best Education (PBed)
- £300 - Additional staffing for attendance and coaching at sports matches and tournaments
- £5000- towards outdoor apparatus to develop EYFS children's physical development
- £500 for additional PE equipment including new netball posts/hoops
- £200 Sport kit for use at competitions and tournaments
- £600 Specialist dance coaching in KS2
