Dear Parents,


Welcome back to the final half term! Our latest integrated learning unit is all about the seaside and under the sea.

This unit will explore many aspects of the seaside from pirates, boats, creatures living under the sea, beaches and camping holidays. Through lots of water and sand exploration the children will learn about floating, sinking, capacity and we will carry out experiments with water.
