

# Measly Monarchs

\* In English, we will start by looking at the Charles Dickens classic Oliver Twist. We will be exploring the characters, the time period and how Charles Dickens wrote such a classic. Children will be able to apply all the skills they have learnt so far this year to write their own adventure stories. Later in the term, we will be diving in to Horrible Histories and writing our own Monarchy biographies.

\* In maths, children will be applying all that we have learnt so far in a variety of problem solving contexts. We will be looking at measurement of money, time and length and how our maths is applied in everyday life. We will also be exploring the world of shape and geometry.
