Year 4 Curriculum News Vikings

Adult readers needed!

If you are free at all during the week to come in and read with the children we would love your help.

What we are learning about this term:

Following on from the Anglo Saxons, our topic this term is the Vikings. This term we will be exploring the Viking struggle for the Kingdom of England to the time of Edward the Confessor. The children will be looking at the resistance by Alfred the Great and further Viking invasions. This will be supported in English where we will be reading the book 'How to train your dragon', looking at instruction writing on how to catch a dragon. We will also be writing diary entries to explore the life of a Viking.



In maths this term we will be focussing on fractions. We will be looking at equivalent fractions and how you can add and subtract fractions with the same denominator.

Guided Reading this term will be exploring the text the 'Mousehole Cat' by Antonia Barber and Nicola Bayley as a class. This is a lovely book and the children will be exploring the imagery and emotions behind the story through letter writing and language exploration.

In art we will be making Viking ship flags, looking at creating detail in the flags through sewing some different patterns. With our topic and Viking day, the children will be looking at classic Viking patterns and embroidery.

Our PSHE this term will be focusing on safety outside of school and going for goals. This is to encourage children in becoming more independent leaners and links to our ICT topic where we are focusing on internet safety in and outside of school.
