Science

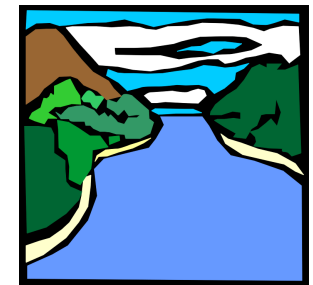


Geography

The children will discover how rivers are formed. They will investigate the processes of a river as it flows and identify features. The children will learn how rivers are used and managed and identify ways to sustain the environments. We will have the opportunity to visit Testwood Lakes on Friday 5th May.

Discussions and poetry
